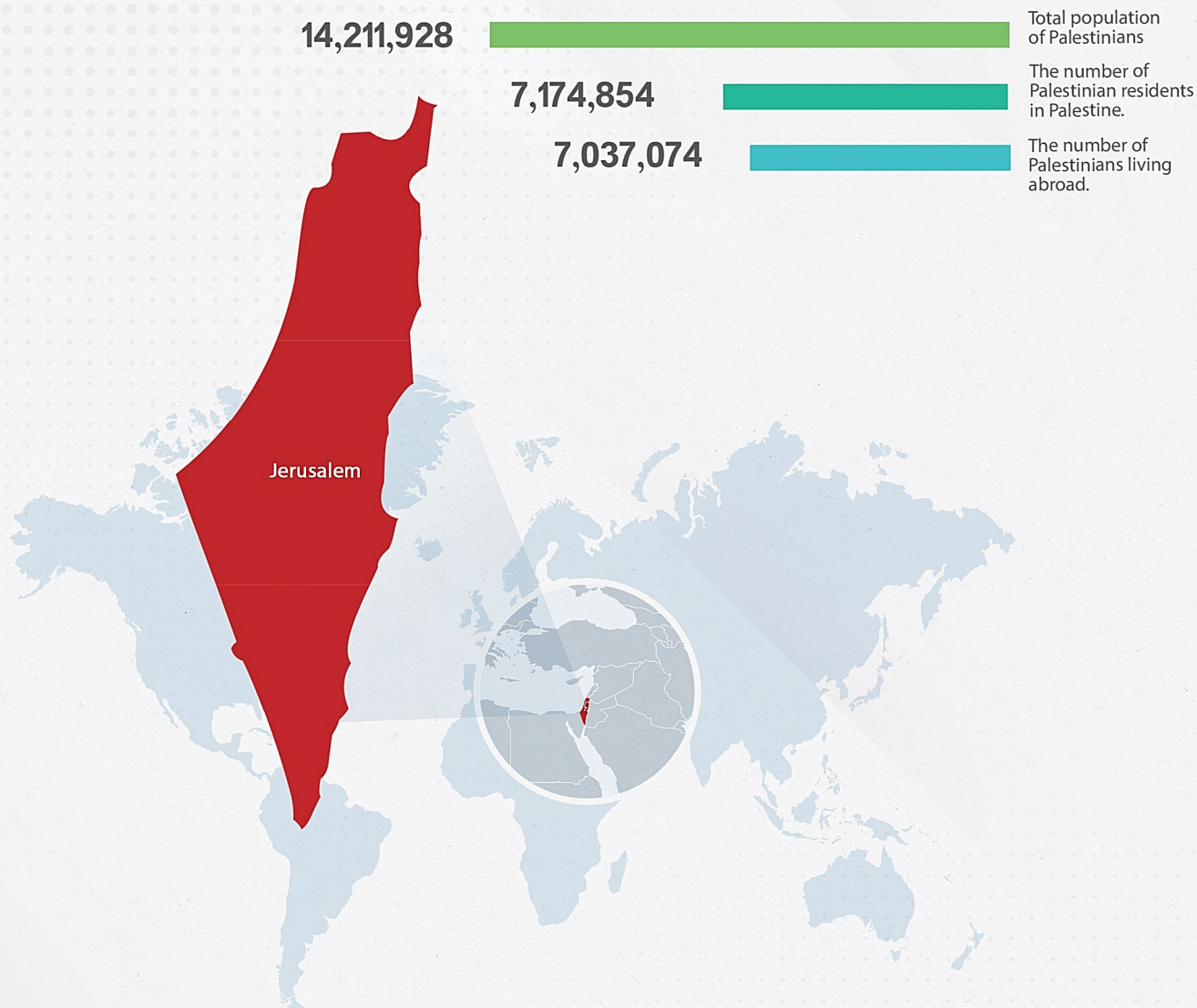

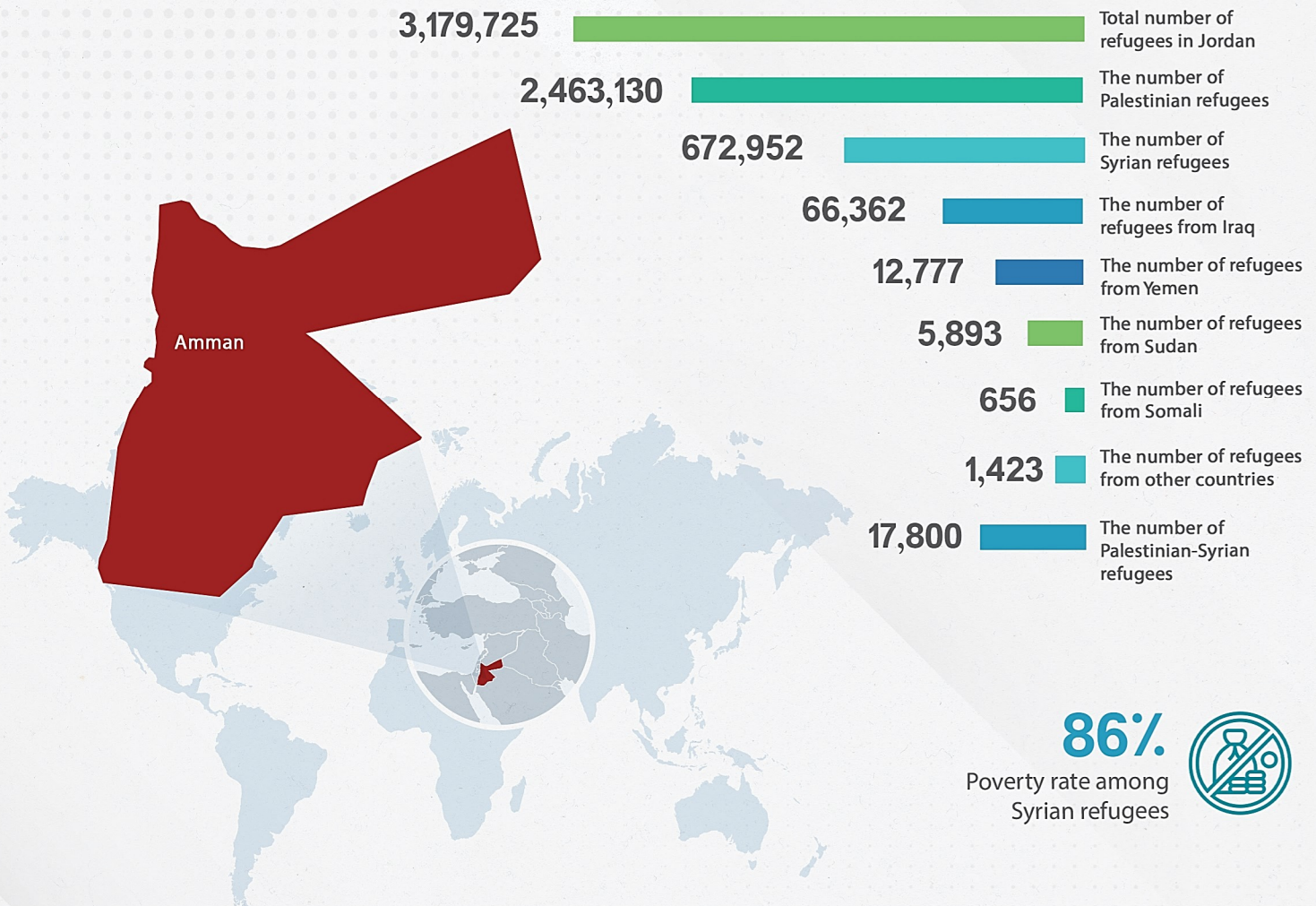

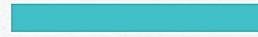

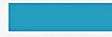

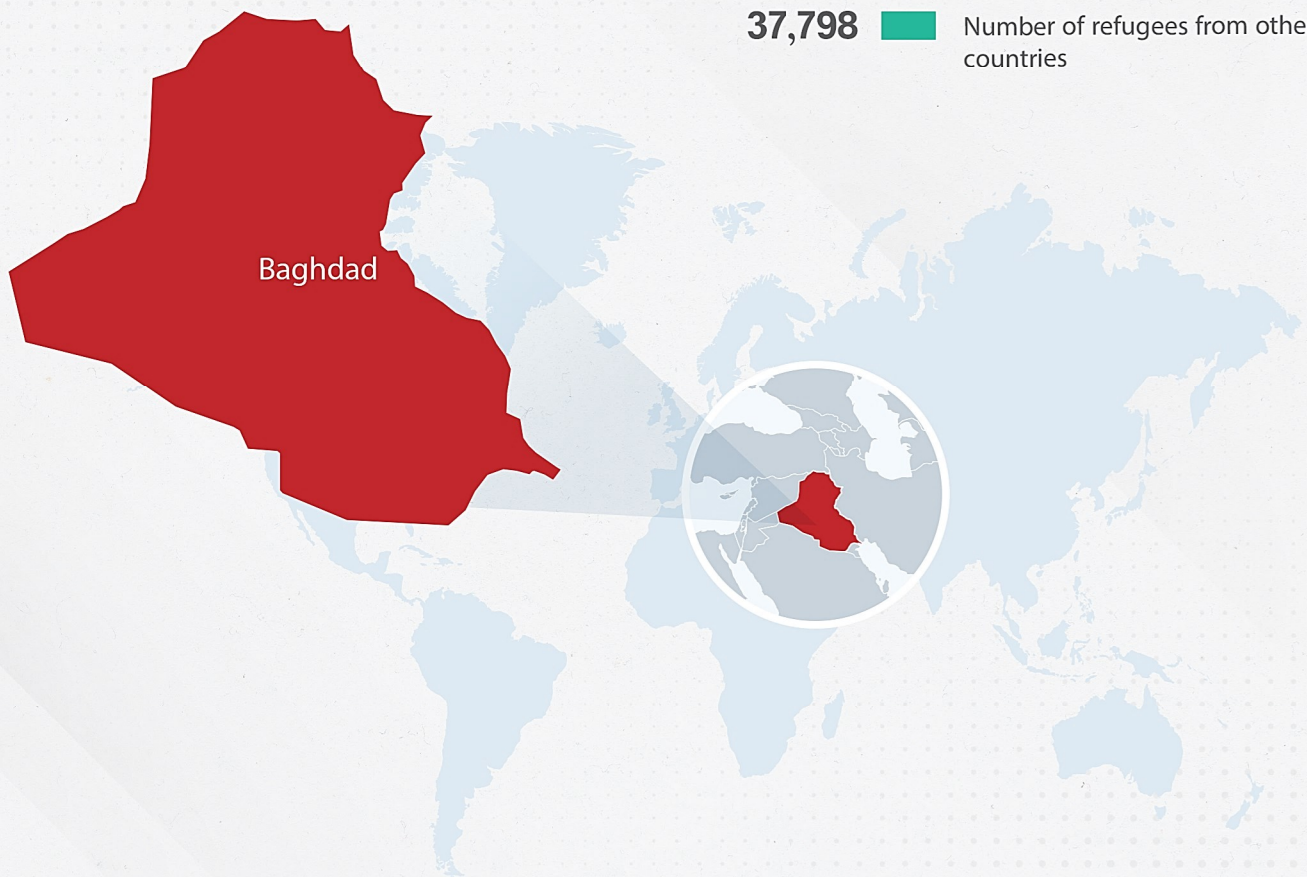

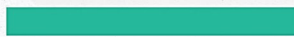

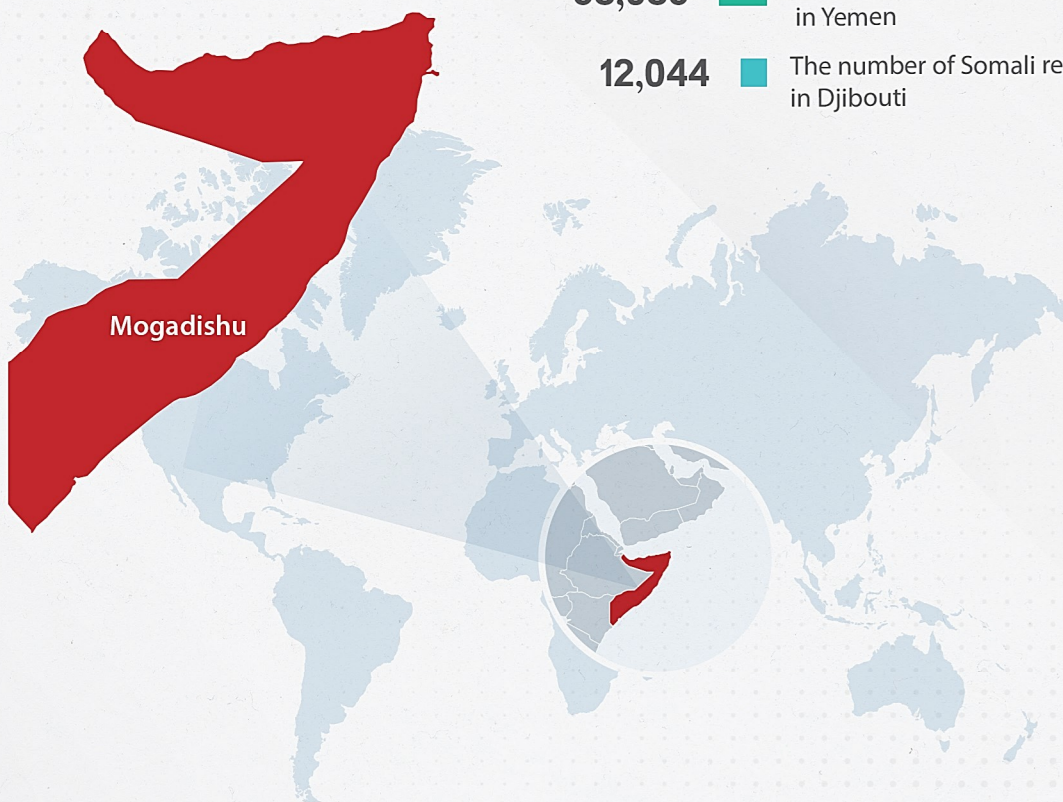

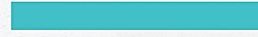
The number of food insecure people in Tigray region

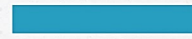
The number of food insecure people in the Amhara and Afar region

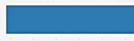

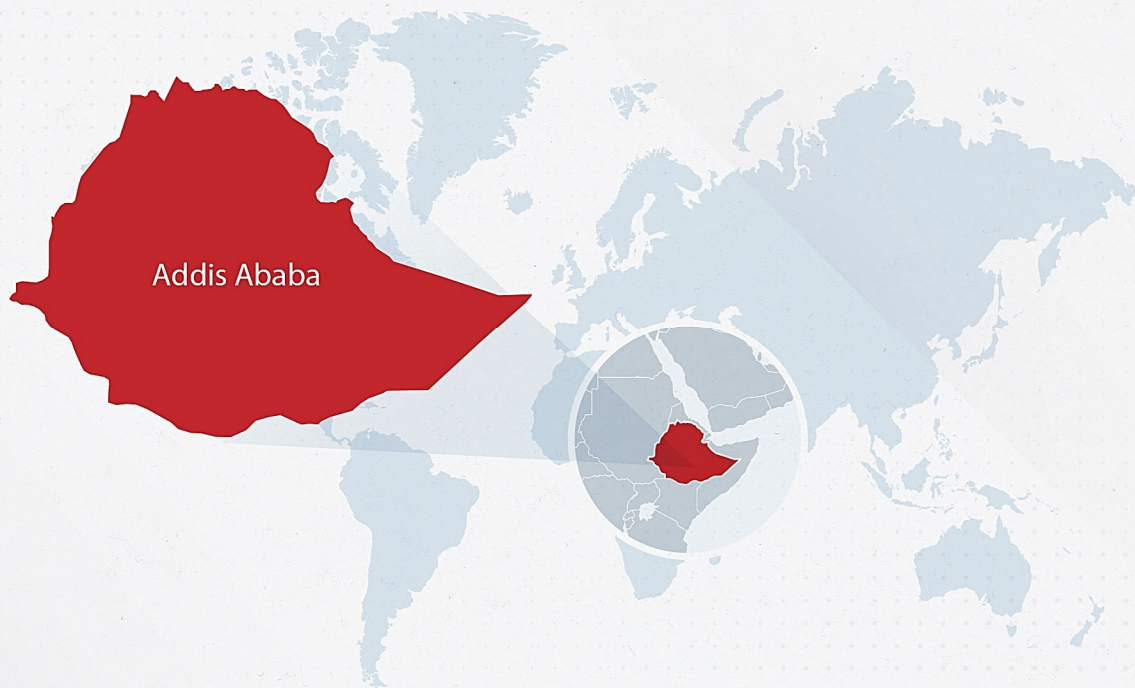

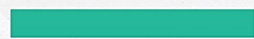

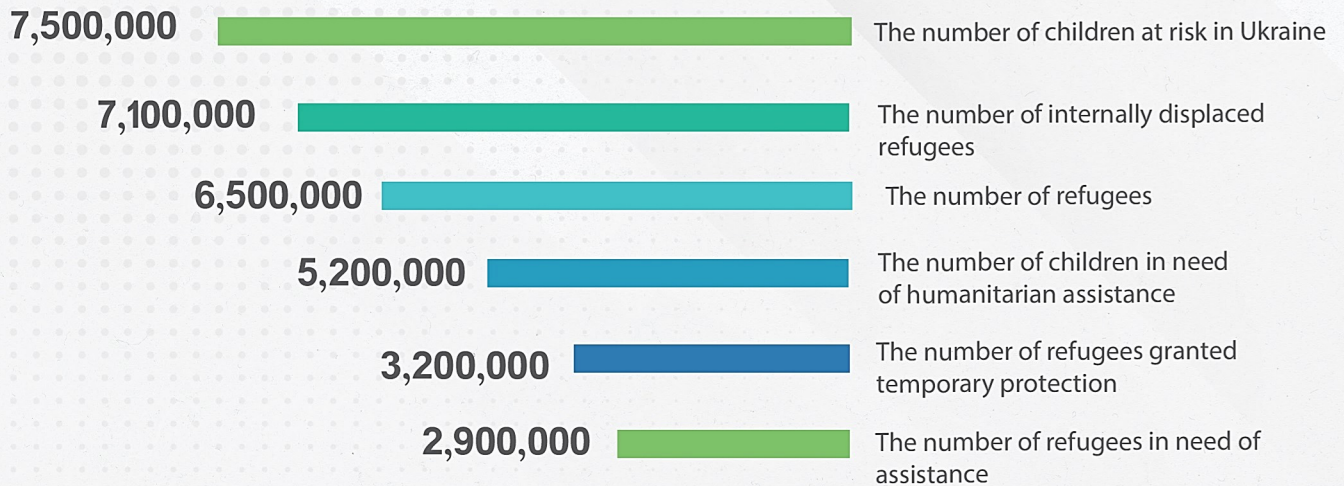
