This report is issued by Medics WorldWide periodically (twice a month, on Mondays). It describes the health and humanitarian situation in the Gaza Strip, and it is based on statistics from the Ministry of Health, WHO, and the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Palestinian Affairs in the Occupied Palestinian Territory (OCHA).

Updates on the Humanitarian and Health Situation in the Gaza Strip

Gaza is on the verge of its last breath!

displacement... Mass forced towards the south amid escalating bombardment (1)



More than one million people in Gaza face renewed terror after receiving an urgent order to evacuate Gaza City

Escape is impossible for many—the elderly, critically ill patients, pregnant women, and the woun



Those who attempt to flee will be accompanied by relentless bombardment. The survivors will end up in overcrowded areas in central and southern Gaza, where there is neither safety nor the basic necessities for survival









The total death toll from malnutrition has risen to 435, including 147 children. Since the IPC declared famine in Gaza, 157 deaths have been recorded, among them 32 children (1)

What is happening in Gaza is not just a humanitarian catastrophe, but a systematic genocide against an entire people The scale of human loss is immense, as Israel deploys ultra-destructive weapons designed for open battlefields

Gaza is being wiped out entirely, families are being forcibly displaced, and people are living in terror. (2)

severe thirst crisis grips the people of Gaza, as water supplies from Mekorot are reduced and Israeli attacks target water pipelines and wells (3)

Gaza is being completely destroyed, turning into a barren land that seems on the verge of becoming uninhabitable

The Reality of Primary Healthcare Centres in the Gaza Strip

Direct destruction of primary healthcare centers in northern and central Gaza during the latest airstrikes (notably: the Beit Hanoun Martyrs Center and the Nuseirat Health Center) (1)

Shortages of fuel and essential medical supplies



A sharp increase in cases of diarrhea, respiratory infections, and malnutrition as a result of the absence of preventive healthcare services (3)



The Reality of Hospitals in Gaza

Al-Rantisi becomes a target... not even patients are safe (2)

Al-Rantisi Specialized Pediatric Hospital was bombed three times consecutively within minutes, despite having 80 patients inside, including intensive care cases and newborns. The hospital has been completely shut down!

It is the only hospital in Gaza that houses oncology and dialysis departments









patients fled under the bombardment, while others stayed with the medical staff amid the risk of death.

We have received patients in very impoverished conditions due to starvation, facing severe risks of malnutrition that can have catastrophic long-term consequences (1)





Gaza Eye Hospital is out of service due to attacks on its surrounding area. (2) The family of Dr. Muhammad Abu Salmiya, Director of Al-Shifa Hospital in Gaza, was directly targeted at their home, resulting in the martyrdom of several family members (3)



The medical teams are working with depleted stocks of essential medicines and life-saving medical supplies



The severe shortage of blood units and their components is worsening the risks of emergency interventions for the wounded (4)



consequences negatively affect a child's cognitive abilities, even if recovery occurs.— Severe overcrowding in the emergency departments of the remaining operational hospitals in Gaza City.









The health crisis has reached a point of no return: doctors are faced with the choice of amputation or death! (1)




Amputation has become the only option for doctors to save the lives of the injured



The Reality of Psychological Health And Education



Psychological support teams have documented cases of children experiencing trauma that leaves them refusing to speak for days, only to suddenly collapse into crying or violent outbursts (1)





"Mama died and didn't come back"... children remain silent for hours before breaking down.





The psychological trauma among children is worsening: nightmares, constant crying, and panic attacks (2)





Children in the Gaza Strip have been stripped of their right to learn. Schools have become shelters, homes have turned into rubble, and there is no place children in 700,000 for education. Over Gaza are deprived of formal education (3)
